BIRD CHARKA

Birds found in Russian folklore may have inspired the stylized form of this silver charka. A jeweled gold and silver-mounted charka shaped as a bird marked Faberge and with workmaster's mark of Anna Ringe, St. Petersburg, with scratched inventory number 2661. The bowl of the nephrite-beaked creature is inscribed in Cyrillic: Christmas Tree, January 4, 1897, indicating it may have been a holiday present or ornament.
