Julius Rappoport (1864-1916)

Description: in the form of the Romanov griffin holding a sword in its right hand and shield in the form of a clock with white enamel dial in its left hand, the pale green marble base with silver beaded border, marked with initials of workmaster, Fabergé in Cyrillic and 88 standard.

PROVENANCE

Presented by Grand Duke Nikolai Nicholaevich to Prince Carol (later Carol I) of Rumania.

Thence to King Ferdinand of Rumania who presented the clock Mme. Mavrodi, Mistress of the Wardrobe to Queen Marie, at Christmas 1917.

Thence to her son, Col. Mavrodi on the occasion of his wedding in 1921.

Purchased by the late A.G.G.de Chastelain.
